Improve your German skills

Do you want to expand your vocabulary and put the finishing touches on your knowledge of German grammar? In this class you will learn to speak, write and read simple German. The course will focus on basic vocabulary, verbs, and the declension of nouns. Additionally, some tenses will be introduced. Important grammatical constructions are built into the framework of each lesson, which are oriented towards day-to-day usage and dialogue. Students will review the German I contents from the book "Taylor's and Haas' *German: A Self Teaching Guide*" and discuss them in more detail. The self-teaching guide is available from GTHS and costs \$20.00. No prerequisite, although many find Beginning Conversational German helpful.
